Emergency Preparedness Drill

We will be practicing an Emergency Preparedness Drill the week of November 16th—20th, depending on the weather. Our goal is not to alarm the children, but simply teach them what we would do if we couldn't stay in our building. For example, if a pipe burst and there was water all over the floor, we would need to stay somewhere else that is safe. One of our evacuation sites is at the Smithsburg Fire Hall which is directly across the alley from the church. The only difference between this and the Fire Drills that we have already been doing is that we will walk the children across the alley to the Fire Hall. We will take an emergency kit with us that has snacks, water, first aid supplies, etc. We are required to do one Emergency Preparedness Drill in the fall and spring of each school year. Talking with your child before we do this drill may help to ease their fears. Please let us know if you have any questions.

Shop With Scrip Gift Card Fundraiser

We will be having a school fundraiser this month called "Shop With Scrip". We have done this for the last two years and it went really well! With the help of over 750 brands, it turns your everyday shopping into earnings for our school. Gift cards are available from tons of different places like WalMart, Amazon, Target, etc. That means that you won't have to spend any extra time selling products, asking for donations, or going to a special fundraising event. Our school can earn money on the gift cards that you purchase. The gift cards you purchase could not only be used for gifts, but also for every day purchases like groceries, gas, dining out, home improvement projects, clothing, travel, and more! Every gift card has a rebate percentage on it, normally between 2% and 16%. That rebate goes directly to our school when a card is purchased at face value. There are several ways to order cards. You can either fill out the order form and send back with payment to the school, order on the mobile app and have physical gift cards sent directly to your home, or purchase e-gift cards directly on your phone. With the holiday shopping season approaching, it is a great time to stock up on gifts for others or purchase gift cards to do your holiday shopping with! 

